

SECOND RESCUE! So last month, Chris and Steph rescued an adorable cat. Turned out she was pregnant and has since given birth to 4 adorable kittens. This month, a second rescue took place. Jesus called him out of the tree and "rescued him" to live a life for Christ. This little doggie was found with a piece of twine wrapped tightly around his muzzle that had been there long enough to embed itself in his muzzle (the white stripes across his nose is the scar it left). He was very thin due to his inability to eat (and probably even drink) when he was found and taken to the Shelter and has been recuperating for the last 3 weeks. We went to visit him on Friday evening when we arrived in Goldendale and we seemed to make a connection. He is (we think) part border collie and part blue heeler and is about 10 months old, though a friend of mine says he could also be part Australian Shepherd. We talked about it all weekend and on Tuesday, July 31st (Mom's birthday!!) on our way back to Canby we made arrangements to pick him up and "foster" him for awhile. We call him Zac (short for Zacchaeus) and are excited that he has fit right in with the family (and even is friendly with our elderly cat Simba). He loves to snuggle and given the opportunity will climb up and nuzzle behind your ears and give you a hug. He



is very, very smart and is already sitting on command and looks up at us when we call his name. Thanks to Goldendale's D.O.G. (Dogs of the Gorge) shelter, for taking him in and making him available to us! We feel so blessed to have him be part of our project! More Zac Tails to come!!
